International Accessibility Conference on Hearing Loops and Hearing Technology

Berlin, 26.09.2017 - Thanks to modern technology, it is now possible for hearing-impaired people to participate in public life. With the topics ranging from technical development, to experience and motivation, the Conference which takes place from the 6th to the 8th October in Berlin has an interesting program. State-of-the-art hearing loop system technology is presented as well as new alternative possibilities and their current application areas.

On Saturday 7th October 2017, Dr. Juliette Sterkens, Hearing Loss Association of America, opens the final round of the conference with her lecture "Looping the World". In a panel discussion, experts from different countries will then discuss the future of hearing loop and assistive listening technology, their possible applications and the benefits for hearing-impaired people.
