## SIGHTSEEING WITH PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION:

(Use a public transport ticket to see Berlin)

**Bus 100 or 200**, double-decker Busses:

Bus 100 takes you on a nice route from Bahnhof Zoo to Alexanderplatz

With Bus 200 return passing by important Sights of Berlin.

## **M29:**

Bus M29 starts at the Hermannplatz in Neukölln and ends in pretty Grunewald.

The fascinating ride takes you through diverse social environments from legendary Kreuzberg, glittering Potsdamer Platz, on to the Breitscheidplatz and finally the quiet Roseneck. That ride takes about an hour.

Take the U5 on the Alexanderplatz towards Hönöw to the Stop Kienberg.

Day Ticket incl. Cable railway is 20€, discounted 18€

An evening entrance fee as of 5PM cost 10€.

Starting at station Nikolaiviertel you can glide by attractions such as Bellevue Palace, House of World Cultures, Government District, Reichstag, Charite, Museumsinsel, Berlin Cathedral, Stadtschloss with Audioguide in many languages.
